

Minutes of Meeting of Weymouth Board of Commissioners

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Village of Weymouth was held on December 1, 2025, in the meeting room at the Medical Centre with Commissioners, Irwin Gaudet, Gary Theriault, and Michel Doucet. Gladys Misner, and Roy Mullen.

Visits were Ashon Gavel and Lester Moulten from the Weymouth Fire Department.

Chairman Irwin Gaudet called the meeting to order at 7:04pm.

The minutes of the meeting of November 3, 2025, were reviewed and were approved by Commissioner Gary Theriault and seconded by Commissioner Michel Doucet.

Business Arising out of the Minutes:

-Commissioner Irwin Gaudet mentioned that the rock at the bridge in Gates Lane has been engraved and painted.

Correspondence:

-Roxanne Mullen received a Annual Capital Expenditures Survey. Roxanne will speak to Murray Betts regarding the survey; one was completed in 2024.

-Commissioner Michel Doucet made the motion to accept the Financial Statement, second by Commissioner Roy Mullen, motion carried.

-A question arose by Commissioner Gary Theriault whether the village has availability to legal advice. Commissioner Irwin Gaudet was not aware of any. It was suggested to reach out to our municipal representative.

New Business:

-Commissioner Gary Theriault brought the blueprints to the new fire hall and was viewed by all in attendance. The new addition will be 60'x60' and used as a community shelter in time of need. Commissioner Theriault mentioned they are still waiting for the cost phases permits. Commissioner Theriault made a motion to pay Kai Morrill for his consultation regarding the new fire hall building. Half to be paid by the village, the remaining half by the Weymouth Fire Department. Commissioner Roy Mullen seconded, motion carried. Commissioner Theriault said this will require the help of corporate sponsors, levels of government funding as well as some fundraising from the village. A public meeting will be held later to provide information to the public.

-Commissioner Gary Theriault made the motion to accept CS Snow Removal to plow and sand the parking lots for the Medical Center and the VON. Commissioner Michel Doucet seconded, motion carried.

-Discussion was brought forward by the members of the Weymouth Fire Department in attendance with regards to using the Bobcat at the firehall for snow removal. It was mentioned that Murray Doucet has retired and Dana Frankland is interested in taking over plowing the sidewalks. This matter will be discussed further at the next meeting in January 2026.
