Financial Reports: An updated financial report was presented by Clerk Treasurer. Year end information will be turned over to auditors, Grant Thornton, in next few days.

Correspondence:

Letter from Canada Revenue Agency outlining criteria for submitting public service body tax claims. To be turned over to village auditors to deal with in conjunction with year end audit.

New Business:

Commissioner Frizzell is to follow up with NS Power on replacement street light for the one destroyed during Tropical storm Arthur in July 2014 in front of the residence of Morton Frankland.

Fire Department have requested to be on the agenda for our next meeting.

VON have received approval for increase in rent to accommodate the expanded storage space-\$100 per month. Quotes from Richard Johns and J & D Electric were reviewed. Moved by Commissioner Raymond, Seconded by Commissioner Gaudet. Motion carried with dissenting vote by Commissioner Frizzell.
